

General Discussion Questions on Racism

How are characters of different races depicted in the text? Are they fully developed, or reduced to stereotypes?

Does the text challenge, reinforce, or complicate contemporary social norms about race?

How does the author's own racial or cultural background influence the depiction of racism in the work?

Which scenes or passages most powerfully illustrate the impact of racism on the characters? Why?

How does the text make you reflect on racism in contemporary society?

Are there lessons or warnings about prejudice and discrimination that remain relevant today?
